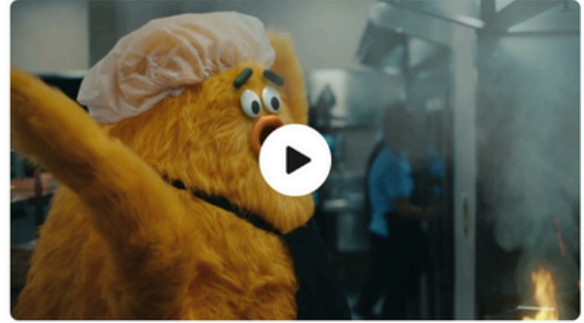

Questions For Your First Day at Work

Download Questions for Your First Day at Work

You might have a lot of questions about your new job on the first day. Here's a few things you can ask, if they haven't been mentioned in your induction.

As you read each question, think about how you would ask it in your own way.

Your first days in the workplace

Entering the workforce for the first time can be intimidating and exciting all at the same time. You will likely have lots of questions about your new job and that's okay. You can ask your manager or a colleague any questions, no matter how silly they seem, as they help keep you safe at work.

Here are a few questions you can ask if they haven't been covered in your induction or you would like more information.

Go-to people at work	Doing your job	Questions that make you go UMM...	Bonus questions
Who do I ask about my hours/ pay/breaks or if I need to change my shift or availability? Who do I contact if I am unable to make a shift due to an illness? What is our policy around sick leave? Who is my buddy, trainer, or supervisor to help me while I learn? Do we have a Health and Safety Representative (HSR)? Who do I tell if I think a staff member or customer's behaviour is not right?	What do I do if I see something unsafe? Can you please show me how to do... again? What do I do if I get injured? If I'm not sure about how to do something, where can I get help?	Who do I ask if I need to go to the bathroom? What do I do if I need to take a break? Where do I take my break? How often do I take a break?	Where are the first aid kit and emergency exits? Can you please send me/print out the induction information?

1. Virtual Reality Game Developer 🎮

2. Ethical Hacker 🛡️

Ethical hackers essentially secure and improve the technology of organisations, looking for vulnerabilities that can lead to a security breach.

3. Software Developer 💻

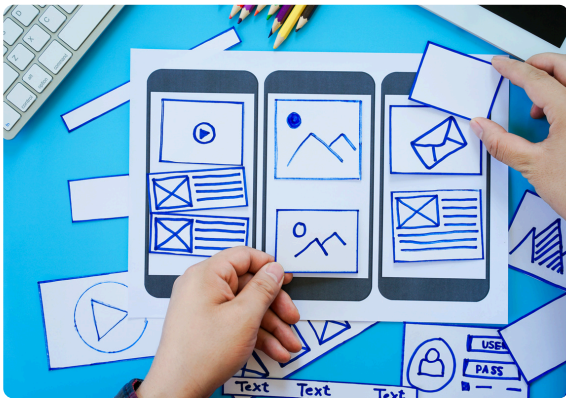

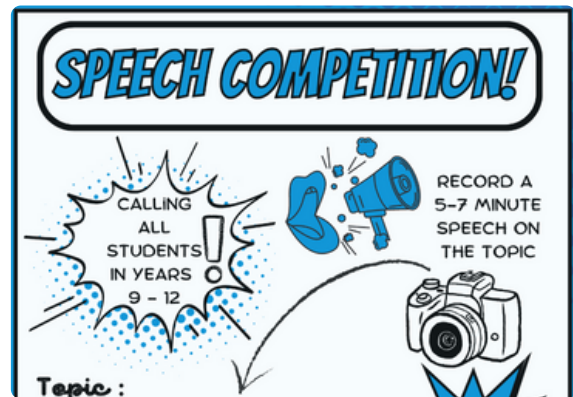
