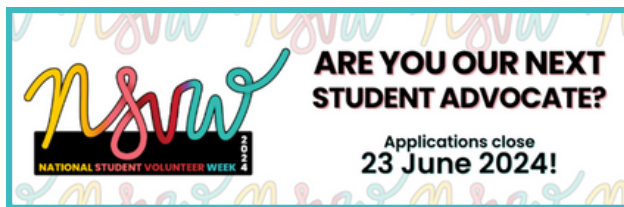
Monash University invites you to show it how you apply design to respond to some of the world's most urgent challenges.

In teams of 2-4, create a poster addressing the theme: How may AI improve life, health and wellbeing for Australians in the future? Win up to \$1000!

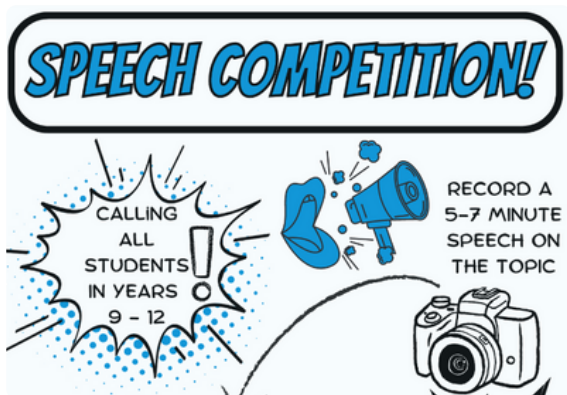
- Open to: Year 10 - 12 students.
