

Stage 1 Geography Fieldwork

Dear parent/guardian,

As part of Stage 1 Geography, students are required to attend a Geography Fieldwork excursion. They will observe and map data along an Urban Transect to be able to complete their AT2 assignment. The trip is also an opportunity for students to meet and work collaboratively with their staff and peers teaching and studying the subject.

Location: Open Access College 1 – 37 Marden Road, MARDEN 5070, Payenham Road, Botanic Road, North Terrace, King William Street.

Date: 22nd of AUGUST 2024

Time: 10:00 am – 3:15 pm

Please arrive at 10:00am and sign in at Student Services where you will meet teachers outside of this area before walking over to the Hall. Students will also be required to sign out at Student Services before leaving at 3:15pm

10:00 am: Students arrive at Student Services and sign in

10:05 am: Briefing. Students meet Huw Bowen and Simonne Wilkinson (staff) in main Open Access College Hall. Recess is eaten before leaving Open Access College

10:30 am: Students are transported to and along the transect route by minibus (map below). Students must sign out at Student Services before leaving the Open Access College site.

10:30 am – 12:30 pm: Students observe and map data onto base maps (provided)

12:30 pm – 1:00 pm: Lunch. Students bring lunch or purchase it at a suitable outlet along the transect route.

1:00 pm – 3:00 pm: Students observe and map data onto base maps.

3:00 pm – 3:15 pm: Debrief at Open Access College

3:15 pm: Students will sign out at Student Services and students will then be dismissed.

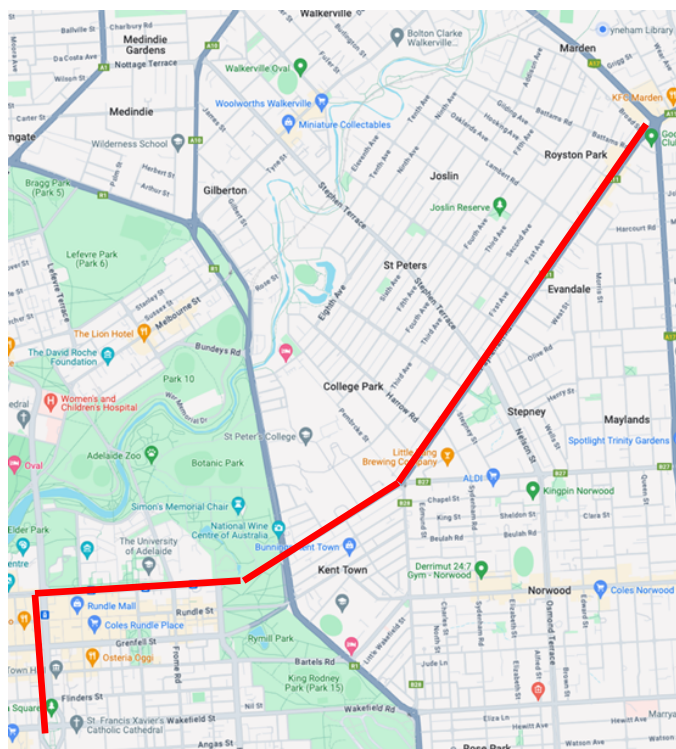
